Amend the amendment by striking out the 3rd para-
graph after the title and inserting in its place the
following:

'Further amend the bill in subsection 6, in the
last line (page 3, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out
the following: "1992." and inserting in its place the
following: '1994, subsection 7 is repealed July 1,
1988, and subsection 8 is repealed July 1, 1990.'

Further amend the amendment by adding before the
statement of fact the following:

'8. Grower's own seed. Any potato grower in
this State, who is propagating seed stock pursuant to
authorization for grower's own seed plot provided by
the rules governing certification of seed potatoes in
the State and whose application to the commissioner
for certification and inspection of a variety that
has not been released to the public was first made
prior to 1982, is exempt from the requirement to com-
ply with subsection 4 for seed potatoes grown in a
grower's own seed plot; provided that the production
from that seed is sold only as chip stock to be pro-
cessed in this State.'
