Certification of seed potatoes' 12 Further amend the bill in subsection 4, in the 13 14 first, 2nd and 3rd lines (page 2, lines 11 to 13 in 15 L.D.) by striking out the following: "In order to encourage and protect investment in the development of 1.5 new potato varieties, for" and inserting in its place 17 the following: 'For' 18 Further amend the bill in subsection δ , in the 19 last line (page 3, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1992." and inserting in its place the 20 21 following: '1994 and subsection 7 is repealed July 1, 22 23 1988. 24 Further amend the bill by adding before the 25 statement of fact the following: 26 '7. Limitation. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the commissioner may certify seed 27 which would otherwise flush out of the certification 28 program, upon application for certification by the grower of the seed and when the commissioner finds 29 30 the following: 31 32 The variety has not been released to the pub-33 lic; 34 The first application to the commissioner for в. 5 certification and inspection of the variety was

1 made prior to 1982; C. The grower now making application to the com-2 missioner grew seed potatoes of this variety in this State which seed was certified in this State 3 4 5 in 1986; 6 D. The seed for which application is now made meets all other requirements and standards of the 7 certification program; and 8 E. The grower's only source of seed of the vari-ety is through the granting of the waiver.' 9 10 11 STATEMENT OF FACT This amendment gives the commissioner the author-12 ity to extend the certification life of certain nonreleased varieties of potato seed for a maximum of 13 14
