Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all
of that part designated "§53-A." and inserting in its
place the following:

The maximum weekly benefit payable under section
54-A, 55-A or 58-A is \$447.92. Beginning on ~~July 17,~~
~~1988~~ August 1, 1988, this maximum benefit level shall
be adjusted annually so that it continues to bear the
same percentage relationship to the state average
weekly wage, as computed by the Maine Unemployment
Insurance Commission, as it did on ~~July 17, 1987~~ Au-
gust 1, 1987.
