Beginning on July-17 1988 August 1, 1988, this maximum benefit level shall be adjusted annually so that it continues to bear the same percentage relationship to the state average weekly wage, as computed by the Maine Unemployment Insurance Commission, as it did on July-171987 August 1, 1987.

23 24 25	This amendment extends the current freeze on the maximum weekly benefit payable under the Workers' Compensation Act for one additional month.
