'Study required. Resolved: That in order to pro-	

13 14 vide an objective, ongoing source of information to 15 the State's sludge and ash landspreading programs, 16 the Environmental Health Unit of the Bureau of Health 17 in the Department of Human Services shall conduct a 18 study of dioxin contamination and possible biological 19 pathways in the environment. The study shall be de-20 signed and conducted in consultation and in conjunction with the Maine Agricultural Experimental Sta-21 tion, Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural 22 Re-23 sources, Department of Environmental Protection, 24 Environmental Protection United States Agency, 25 Cobbossee Watershed District and Monmouth town offi-26 In order to minimize environmental contaminacials. 27 tion with dioxin, research shall be conducted either: 28 (1)In field plots that are currently being amended with dioxin-contaminated sludge, in which case rates 29 30 or sludge applications shall not be increased for the 31 purposes of this research above those currently per-32 (2) In impermeable containers set out in a mitted; 33 field that shall be removed at the conclusion of the 34 experiment; and (3) In pots maintained in a The objective of the study shall be to 35 greenhouse. 36 investigate the environmental fate of sludge-borne 37 dioxin in terms of the uptake of dioxin by agricul-38 tural crops and the persistence of dioxin in soil. 39 Information obtained from this study will be made 40public and subject to peer review. The Environmental 41 Health Unit shall assess the significance of the
