1 AN ACT Relating to the Issuance of Bonds or
2 Notes for Union Schools.
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 20-A MRSA §2102, sub-§§3 and 4 are enacted to
7 read:

8 3. School construction projects. A union school
9 agreement may include procedures for undertaking
10 school construction projects for union schools in ac-
11 cordance with chapter 609. If the union school
12 agreement provides for the establishment of a joint
13 union school committee, that committee shall have the
14 responsibilities of a building committee and a munic-
15 ipal school board under chapter 609. If no provision
16 is made for a joint union school committee, the

1 school boards of the municipalities which are parties
2 to the union school agreement shall carry out those
3 responsibilities by concurrent action.

4 4. Borrowing. Unless otherwise provided in the
5 union school agreement, the percentage of the cost of
6 a school construction project which is borne by each
7 municipality which is a party to a union school
8 agreement shall be the same as the percentage of the
9 union school operating costs borne by that municipal-
10 ity in the year in which the school construction
11 project receives concept approval. A referendum vote
12 shall be conducted by each municipality to authorize
13 the issuance of its percentage of the bonds or notes
14 for a school construction project for a union school
15 in accordance with section 15904, subsection 1. Sub-
16 ject to the requirements of chapter 609, each municipi-
17 ality which is a party to a union school agreement
18 may issue bonds or notes pursuant to Title 30, sec-
19 tions 5152 and 5153 for school construction purposes
20 to finance its percentage share of the cost of a
21 school construction project for a union school.

22 STATEMENT OF FACT

23 This bill establishes procedures for the issuance
24 of bonds for the construction of union schools.
