#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

Resolve, to Require the Finance Authority of Maine in Conjunction with the Department of Environmental Protection to Devise a Plan to Financially Assist Small Filling Station Operators and Owners to Modernize their Fuel Storage Facilities.

Department plan. Resolved: That the Finance Authority of Maine in conjunction with the Department of Environmental Protection shall establish a plan to address the issues involved in financially assisting small gasoline station owners and operators in the modernization of fuel storage facilities; and be it further

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Report. Resolved: That these agencies shall
submit their report, together with any necessary im plementing legislation, to the Second Regular Session
of the 113th Legislature no later than January 15,
1988.

### STATEMENT OF FACT
