AN ACT Concerning Motor Vehicle Inspections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

29 MRSA §2502-A is enacted to read:

§2502-A. Newly registered vehicles; inspections

Notwithstanding section 2502, newly registered
vehicles, except those exempt under section 2506,
shall be inspected no later than 7 days after the
most recent registration or transfer of ownership of
that vehicle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill, which is modeled after a New Hampshire
3 law, provides a 7-day grace period from the time a
4 motor vehicle is newly registered or ownership of a
5 vehicle is transferred to the time when it must be
6 inspected.

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
