STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Exempt Certain Restaurants from
Restroom Requirements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

22 MRSA §1684, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 171, §§1
and 2, is amended to read:

§1684. Enforcement

This chapter shall be enforced by the Division of
Health Engineering. Anyone violating this chapter or
rules under this chapter commits a civil violation
for which a forfeiture of not more than \$200 may be
adjudged, except that any restaurant licensed and op-
erating before January 1, 1987, shall not be in vio-
lation of this chapter. Each day of violation shall
be considered a separate offense.

This bill exempts restaurants which were in existence before January 1, 1987, from the restroom facilities requirement.
