AN ACT to Develop a Coordinated Local Response to Adolescent Pregnancy.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

### STATEMENT OF FACT

The State must assume a position of leadership in policy, planning and programming in the area of teen pregnancy and parenting. This bill provides that leadership by establishing an office within the Department of Human Services, the Division of Maternal and Child Health, to encourage and support local action councils, organizations and programs.

These local action councils, programs or organizations will work to develop plans and programs within the community, integrate statewide efforts to stimulate local response, coordinate existing resources to avoid duplication of work and build local action strategies built upon existing opportunities.

The state office will be staffed with personnel trained to organize, assist and educate local groups and organizations in the development of local action 2 3 plans.

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
