11 12 13	Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 2, lines 3 to 19 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
14 15 16 17 18	'4. Authorization not required. The authorization required by subsection 1 shall not apply to any public water supply which receives or purchases less than 50% of its total annual water supply from another public water supply authorized to add fluoride to its water supply.'
20	STATEMENT OF FACT
21 22 23 24 25 26	This amendment clarifies that water utilities which receive water from a fluoridated water supply by virtue of a cross connection between the 2 systems may continue to receive such water without the necessity of a fluoride election so long as it is receiving less than half of its water in that fashion.
