COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 329, L.D. 957,
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Election Procedures and the
Effects of Interconnected Water Lines in Water
Fluoridation Referenda."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all
of subsection 4 (page 2, lines 3 to 19 in L.D.) and
inserting in its place the following:

'4. Authorization not required. The authoriza-
tion required by subsection 1 shall not apply to any
public water supply which receives or purchases less
than 50% of its total annual water supply from anothe-
r public water supply authorized to add fluoride to
its water supply.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that water utilities
which receive water from a fluoridated water supply
by virtue of a cross connection between the 2 systems
may continue to receive such water without the neces-
sity of a fluoride election so long as it is receiv-
ing less than half of its water in that fashion.
