1 AN ACT to Change the Water Quality
2 Classification of the Carrabassett
3 River to Class A.
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 38 MRSA §467, sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1985,
8 c. 698, §15, is repealed and the following enacted in
9 its place:

10 B. Carrabassett River Drainage.

11 (1) Carrabassett River, main stem.

12 (a) Above a point located 1.0 mile
13 above the railroad bridge in North
14 Anson - Class A.

1 (b) From a point located 1.0 mile
2 above the railroad bridge in North
3 Anson to its confluence with the Kenne-
4 bec River - Class C.

5 (2) Carrabasset River, tributaries.

6 (a) All tributaries entering the
7 Carrabasset River above its confluence
8 with the West Branch - Class A.

9 (b) Gilman Stream (New Portland) from
10 the bridge at New Portland to its con-
11 fluence with the Carrabasset River -
12 Class C.

13 (c) Harris Brook (New Portland) below
14 Route 16 in Village of North New Port-
15 land to its confluence with Gilman
16 Stream - Class C.

17 (d) Mill Stream (Anson) from the rail-
18 road bridge in North Anson Village to
19 its confluence with the Carrabasset
20 River - Class C.

21 (e) Stanley Stream (Kingfield) - Class
22 C.

23 (f) West Branch of the Carrabasset
24 River and its tributaries - Class A.

25 STATEMENT OF FACT

26 The people of Kingfield have worked diligently
27 for many years to rid the Carrabasset River of its
28 raw sewage pollution. This accomplishment can now
29 become a complete reality with the Class A designa-
30 tion.
