8 Spruce Budworm Management Program is necessary in or-  
9 der to establish preproject taxes to be assessed on  
10 landowners in the Spruce Fir Forest Protection Dis-  
11 trict; and

12 Whereas, the uncertainty of the need for a spray  
13 project in 1988 necessitates modification in the  
14 Maine Spruce Budworm Management Act to allow the di-  
15 rector to plan for that contingency; and
