STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to Provide for the Printing of a
Veterans' Directory.

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4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 37-B MRSA §503, sub-§§4-A and 4-B are enacted to
7 read:

8 4-A. Directory. The director shall annually
9 publish a directory of all residents of this State
10 listed in the records maintained under subsection 4.
11 The directory shall contain the following information
12 on each veteran:

13 A. Last name, middle initial and first name;

14 B. Date and place of birth;

1 C. Residence at the time the veteran entered the
2 armed forces;

3 D. The branch of service in which the veteran
4 served;

5 E. The veteran's service serial number;

6 F. The veteran's rank at the time of his dis-
7 charge;

8 G. Military subgrouping in which the veteran
9 served; and

10 H. Date of the veteran's discharge from the
11 armed forces and his rating at that time.

12 The directory shall be distributed without charge to
13 every library in the State and to such other organi-
14 zations or persons as the director determines.

15 4-B. Fund. An amount equal to 1% of the taxes
16 collected pursuant to Title 36, Part 3, shall be held
17 by the Treasurer of State as a special fund to be
18 used solely for the purpose of collecting the infor-
19 mation required by subsections 4 and 4-A, compiling
20 that information and publishing and distributing the
21 directory. That fund shall constitute a nonlapsing
22 fund from which money may be expended under the di-
23 rection of the director.

24 STATEMENT OF FACT

25 The purpose of this bill is to provide for the
26 publication and distribution of a Maine veterans' di-
27 rectory to be funded through sales and use tax reve-
28 nues.

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
