STATEMENT OF FACT

18 The State Employee Assistance Program has become an invaluable program for helping employees at all 19 levels with problems that affect their work. 20 This saves the State the costs of absenteeism, injuries 21 22 and training new employees. The current funding lev-23 el does not permit adequate statewide coverage or 24 sufficient Employee Assistance Program training pro-25 grams for supervisors. These new positions will ad-26 dress this need.
