#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Require the Reporting of the Value of Political Advertising when Fairness Leads to the Giving of Equal Time.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1017, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 161, §6, is amended to read:

5. <u>Content.</u> A report required under this section must contain the itemized accounts of contributions received and the name, address, occupation and principal place of business, if any, of each person who has made a contribution aggregating in excess of \$50 for that report filing period. It must contain the itemized expenditures made or authorized, the purpose of each expenditure and the name of each pay-

1 and creditor. Total contributions with respect to ee an election of less than \$500 and total expenditures 2 3 of less than \$500 need not be itemized. The report 4 must contain a statement of any loan of money in an aggregate amount of \$500 or more to a candidate by a financial institution made during the period covered 5 6 7 by the report, whether or not the loan is defined as 8 a contribution under section 1012, subsection 2, par-9 agraph A.

10 The report must contain a disclosure of the date, 11 time, type and duration of any radio or television 12 broadcast time afforded to a candidate when fairness 13 leads to giving equal time, excluding an appearance 14 by a candidate on any:

- 15 A. Bona fide newscast;
- 16 B. Bona fide news interview;
- 17 C. Bona fide news documentary; or
- 18 D. On-the-spot coverage of a bona fide news event, including, but not limited to, political conventions and activities incidental to those conventions.

Sec. 3. 21-A MRSA §1019, sub-§§4 and 5 are enacted to read:

4. Disclosure of broadcast time. The report must contain a disclosure of the date, time, type and duration of any radio or television broadcast time afforded to a candidate or question when fairness leads to giving equal time, excluding a broadcast of any:

5. Exemption; broadcasts. For purposes of this section, a radio or television broadcast station is not required to disclose in the report as a contribution the fair market value of any radio or television broadcast ime afforded to any person when fairness leads to iving equal time. A station shall provide upon the request of any person, the information necessary to fulfill reporting requirements under this subchapter and subchapter IV.

**Sec. 4.** 21-A MRSA \$1053, sub-\$7, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 161, \$6, is amended to read:

7. <u>Contributions to committee</u>. The names and mailing addresses of contributors who donate in excess of \$50 each year to the committee with amount or value of each contribution at the time of registration. Any person who makes contributions on an installment basis, the total of which exceeds \$50 in the calendar year, is considered a contributor to be identified under this subsection.

The report must contain a disclosure of the date, time, type and duration of any radio or television broadcast time afforded to a candidate or question when fairness leads to giving equal time, excluding a broadcast of any:

## STATEMENT OF FACT

9 The purpose of this bill is to require the dis-10 closure of the date, time, type and duration of any 11 radio or television air time given to a candidate, 12 party committee, other political committee or PAC 13 when fairness leads to giving equal time under a 14 fairness doctrine. The value of such time does not 15 have to be reported under this bill as a contribution 16 by a radio or television station.
