7	22 MRSA §396-D, sub-§10, ¶C is enacted to read:
8	C. Notwithstanding any rule established by the
9	commission, in its consideration of the factors
0	enumerated in this section, the commission shall
1	accept and use all financial information provided
2	by any hospital that has been developed and re-
3	ported in accordance with Generally Accepted Ac-
4	counting Principles as revised, revoked or
5	amended by the Financial Accounting Standards
6	Board

2	Most hospitals are now required to report finan-
3	cial information to directors, trustees and others in
4	accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Princi-
5	ples. They then must redo some or all of this ac-
6	counting information to report the same or similar
7	information to the Health Care Finance Commission.
	This bill allows the hospitals to provide the commis-
9 7	sion with the same information they use in their own
10	financial reports, if they are done according to Gen-
11	eral Accepted Accounting Principles, rather than
12	reworking the data again to meet the reporting re-
13	quirements of the Health Care Finance Commission.

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
