HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 773, L.D. 1036,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Election Laws Regarding
Persons Incarcerated in Correctional Facilities."

Amend the bill in subsection 14 by inserting at
the end the following:

'A person incarcerated in a correctional facility
may apply to register to vote in any municipality
where that person has previously had a fixed habita-
tion and to which he intends to return.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows a person, who is incarcer-
ated in a correctional facility, to register to vote
in a municipality where that person previously re-
sided and intends to return.
