8	14. Persons incarcerated in correctional facili-
9	ties. The residence of a person incarcerated in a
10	correctional facility, as defined in Title 34-A, sec-
11	tion 1001, does not include the municipality where a
12	person is incarcerated unless the person had resided
13	in that municipality prior to incarceration.

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This new draft keeps the substance of the original bill, but places the language in a separate subsection. "Penal institution" is changed to "correctional facility" which is currently defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-A, section 1001. The title has been changed to more accurately reflect

the substance of the original bill.
