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## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 352, L.D. 1044

## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment eliminates the voluntary statewide 3 building code from the bill. It also eliminates the 4 requirement for an Attorney General fact sheet in 5 conjunction with the home construction portion of the 6 bill, which portion now becomes the whole bill. It 7 raises from \$500 to \$1,400 the value of those home 8 construction contracts which are required to be in 9 writing.
