NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend the Hunting Laws Concerning
Vinalhaven.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

12 MRSA §7458, sub-§14, as enacted by PL 1979, c.
420, §1, is amended to read:

14. Illegal use of firearm in Southport. A per-
son is guilty of illegal use of a firearm in
Vinalhaven--er Southport if he uses any firearm other
than a shotgun in the Towns Town of Vinalhaven--er
Southport or the islands within their its confines.
