4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6 7	12 MRSA $$7458$, sub- $$14$, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, $$1$, is amended to read:
8 9 10 11	14. Illegal use of firearm in Southport. A person is guilty of illegal use of a firearm in Vinalhaven-or Southport if he uses any firearm other than a shotgun in the Towns Town of Vinalhaven-or Southport or the islands within their its confines.

The purpose of this bill is to permit hunting in Vinalhaven with firearms other than a shotgun.
