1 AN ACT to Amend the Definition of Seasonal  
2 Under the Employment Security Law.  
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
5 follows:

6 26 MRSA §1251, sub-§3, ¶A, as amended by PL 1983,  
7 c. 750, §2, is further amended to read:

8 A. Any hotel, motel, inn, variety store, trading  
9 post, sporting camp or other lodging facility,  
10 including camps operated for boys and girls, res-  
11 taurants and other eating establishments, which  
12 customarily conducts its operations which are  
13 primarily related to the production of its char-  
14 acteristic goods or services for a regularly re-  
15 curring period or periods of less than 26 weeks  
16 in any one year shall be deemed seasonal.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to include variety stores and trading posts which are open less than 26 weeks a year as seasonal under the Employment Security Law.

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
