1 AN ACT to Restore the 8% Discount to
2 Retailers of Alcoholic Beverages.
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 28 MRSA §204, 2nd¶, as repealed and replaced by
7 PL 1983, c. 824, Pt. W, is amended to read:

8 The commission shall sell to agency stores and
9 licensees spirituous and vinous liquor, except table
10 wine, for a price of 10% less than the retail price
11 established for the state retail stores, provided
12 that the discount shall not apply to federal taxes
13 levied on or after November 1, 1941.

FISCAL NOTE

2 This bill would result in loss of General Fund
3 revenues of \$780,000 in fiscal years 1987-88 and
4 \$1,040,000 in 1988-89.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to restore the 8%
7 discount to retailers of alcoholic beverages.

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
