Whereas, under current law, the Legislature must act on the Androscoggin and Aroostook County budgets by April 1st; and

Whereas, the deadlines established by law must be changed to allow sufficient time to properly accomplish this work; and

- Whereas, if this legislation is not effective immediately, Androscoggin and Aroostook Counties will he forced to operate under an outdated budget; and

 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
- these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

- 5. Final budget approval. Prior to January 15th of the fiscal year for which the budget is prepared, the budget committee shall submit the proposed budget
- to the Legislature. The Legislature shall approve or disapprove the budget as submitted prior to April 19 lst May 1st of each year.
- If the Legislature disapproves of the budget, the budget committee shall submit within 15 calendar days, new budget proposals in accordance with subsection 1 and the provisions of this section shall be followed until a budget is finally approved.
