1 AN ACT to Require that Loads of Gravel, Sand,  
2 Crushed Stone, Wood Chips, Building  
3 Debris or Rubbish be Secure to Prevent  
4 Spillage.

6 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
7 follows:

8 29 MRSA §1752, as amended by PL 1977, c. 32, is  
9 further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph  
10 to read:

11 No person may operate or cause to be operated  
12 upon any public way a vehicle with a load of gravel,  
13 sand, crushed stone, rubbish, wood chips, building  
14 debris or trash, unless the load is covered or other-  
15 wise secured or confined to prevent any portion of  
16 the load from falling from or spilling out of the ve-  
17 hicle.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill requires that vehicles traveling on public ways with loads of gravel, sand, crushed stone, wood chips, building debris or rubbish be covered, confined or secured to prevent any of the load from spilling out of the vehicle.

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
