**AN ACT to Require Workers' Compensation
Insurance Providers to Publicly Post
Rates Annually by January 1st.**

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5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 39 MRSA §22-E is enacted to read:

8 §22-E. Notice of rates

9 Every insurance company issuing workers' compen-
10 sation insurance policies shall file, annually, by
11 January 1st, with the following, a list of all pro-
12 jected rates relating to workers' compensation insur-
13 ance for the ensuing year:

14 1. Maine Chamber of Commerce. The Maine Chamber
15 of Commerce;

1 2. Department of Financial and Professional Reg-
2 ulation. The Department of Financial and Profession-
3 al Regulation; and

4 3. Workers' Compensation Commission. The Work-
5 ers' Compensation Commission.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this bill is to require insurers
8 providing workers' compensation insurance to give no-
9 tice of rates of that insurance to the Maine Chamber
10 of Commerce, the Department of Financial and Profes-
11 sional Regulation and the Workers' Compensation Com-
12 mission in order that employees have the opportunity
13 to accurately budget for workers' compensation premi-
14 um costs.

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
