9 LO L1 L2	G. A public school teacher who leaves service in the State to teach children in a public school in Canada shall be allowed service credit for that service, not to exceed 2 years, if:
L3 L4 L5	(1) The teacher returns to active teaching service in the State within one year of the completion of the service in Canada: and

1	(2) The teacher pays into the retirement
2	system the same amount of contributions
3	which would have been made if the service
4	had been rendered in the State, including

STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This bill allows Maine teachers who leave the 9 State to teach in Canada to purchase up to 2 years of credit in the State Retirement System. They must return to teach in Maine within one year of completing teaching outside of Maine to claim the credit.

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
