1 **AN ACT to Reduce the Burden of Property Taxes**
2 **on Persons Who are Elderly and to**
3 **Count the Years 1983, 1984 and 1985**
4 **when the Income Allowance was not**
5 **Increased with the Increase in Social**

8 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
9 follows:

10 36 MRSA §6108, first ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c.
11 698, §189, is further amended to read:

12 No claim otherwise allowable may be granted to
13 claimants of single member households with household
14 income in excess of \$5,600 in calendar year 1980 and
15 ~~\$6,200~~ \$7,600 in each succeeding year for which re-
16 lief is requested; and no claim otherwise allowable

1 may be granted to claimants of heushelds households
2 of 2 or more members with income in excess of \$6,700
3 in calendar year 1980 and ~~\$7,400~~ \$8,800 in each suc-
4 ceeding year for which relief is requested.
