IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Prohibit the Gathering of Petition
Signatures for Initiated Bills at
Voting Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

Sec. 1. 21-A MRSa §682, sub-§3, ¶B, as enacted
by PL 1985, c. 161, §6, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 21-A MRSa §682, sub-§§4 and 5 are en-
acted to read:

4. Gathering signatures. No person may solicit
or take signatures for any initiative or referendum
petition within 250 feet of the entrance to either
the voting place or the registrar's office.
