Recreation lands. Resolved: That certain state-owned lands formerly associated with the Pineland Center and now under the management authority of the Bureau of Public Lands be developed as low-intensity recreation lands to include such recreation facilities as nature trails, hiking and biking paths, cross-country ski trails and picnic areas; and be it further

Development. Resolved: That the Department of

Conservation, through the Bureau of Parks and Recreation and the Bureau of Public Lands, shall devise the recreation lands plan and site development in cooperation with other state, local and private agen-

This resolve provides that the Department of Conservation, in cooperation with other state, local and private agencies, develop state-owned lands around the Pineland Center for recreational purposes and to preserve open space in southern Maine.

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
