**Resolve, to Create Public Recreation
Facilities on Certain State-owned
Properties.**

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5 **Recreation lands. Resolved:** That certain state-
6 owned lands formerly associated with the Pineland
7 Center and now under the management authority of the
8 Bureau of Public Lands be developed as low-intensity
9 recreation lands to include such recreation facili-
10 ties as nature trails, hiking and biking paths,
11 cross-country ski trails and picnic areas; and be it
12 further

13 **Development. Resolved:** That the Department of
14 Conservation, through the Bureau of Parks and Recre-
15 ation and the Bureau of Public Lands, shall devise
16 the recreation lands plan and site development in co-
17 operation with other state, local and private agen-
18 cies.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This resolve provides that the Department of Conservation, in cooperation with other state, local and private agencies, develop state-owned lands around the Pineland Center for recreational purposes and to preserve open space in southern Maine.

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
