# AN ACT to Amend the Teacher Recognition Grants Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13502, sub-§1, ¶¶B and C, as
  enacted by PL 1983, c. 859, Pt. J, §§2 and 7, are
  amended to read:
  - B. Private secondary schools approved for tuition whose school enrollments are at least 60% publicly-funded students as determined by the previous school year's October to April average enrollment; and
  - C. Schools operated by an agency of State Government, including the following:

23 24 25 26 27	Sec. 4. Application. Section 1 of this Act shall apply retroactively to the 1985-86 school year to those persons who would otherwise qualify for teacher recognition grants pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 13503-A.
