3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
4 follows:

5 Sec. 1. 28 MRSA §656 is enacted to read:

6 §656. Restrictions on wholesale licensees

7 No malt liquor or wine wholesale licensee may
8 sell liquor to the commission.

9 Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §901-A is enacted to read:

10 §901-A. Sales to commission

11 The commission shall purchase liquor only from
12 firms whose sales representatives are licensed as
13 sales representatives by the commission.
