1 AN ACT to Give Local Election Wardens
2 Authority to Select Locations where
3 Signatures may be Collected.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 21-A MRSa §662, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

8 4. Collection of signatures. He may select and
9 designate a specific location at the voting place
10 where the collection of petition signatures may take
11 place. If any person collects signatures outside of
12 the location so designated, the warden may direct re-
13 moval of that person pursuant to subsection 2, para-
14 graph A.
