STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Prohibit Initial Service Charges by
Public Utilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

35 MRSA §80-A is enacted to read:

§80-A. Electrical access fee prohibited

No public electric utility may impose any service
charge or fee for the installation of a 200 amp elec-
trical entrance.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill prohibits an electric utility from charging for the installation of a 200 amp electrical entrance.

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
