7 SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 856, L.D. 1150,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Strengthen the Efforts of the Maine
9 Potato Industry and the Responsibility of the Maine
10 Potato Board to Improve the Quality of Maine
11 Tablestock Potatoes."

12 Amend the bill in section 18 by striking out all
13 of subsection 2-A and inserting in its place the fol-
14 lowing:

15 '2-A. Other than Maine bag. No person may pack
16 potatoes in any consumer pack on which the word
17 "Maine" appears unless the pack is a Maine bag, ex-
18 cept that the word "Maine" may appear on any consumer
19 pack if it is the name and address of a producer,
20 packer or any other person at the bottom of the pack
21 and in letters not taller than 1/4 inch.'

22 Further amend the bill by inserting after section
23 21 the following:

24 'Sec. 22. Transition. Rules adopted under this
25 article and in effect on the effective date of this
26 Act shall remain in effect until amended or replaced
27 as provided herein.'


