Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 6 7 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; 8 and 9 Whereas, Hancock County has certain expenses and 10 liabilities which must be met as they become due; and 11 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the 12 year 1987 hereinafter mentioned be immediately as-13 sessed in order to provide the required revenue for 14 the county; and Page 1-LR2225
