IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

Resolve, Authorizing Floris Doiron of Auburn to Bring a Civil Action Against the State of Maine.

Floris Doiron; authorized to sue the State of Maine. Resolved: That Floris Doiron of Auburn, County of Androscoggin and State of Maine, who suffered ankle, knee, femur and associated injuries as a result of an automobile accident allegedly caused by the improper placement of a stop sign at the intersection of Routes 117 and 219 in Turner, Maine, is authorized to bring suit against the State of Maine.

13 This action is to be brought in the Superior 14 Court for the County of Androscoggin within one year 15 from the passage of this resolve, against the State 16 of Maine for damages, if any, and the conduct of this 17 action shall be according to the practice of actions

1 or proceedings between parties in the Superior Court. 2 The liabilities of the parties and elements of dam-3 ages, if any, shall be the same as liabilities and elements of damage as between individuals. The com-4 5 plaint issuing out of the Superior Court under the 6 authority of this resolve shall be served on the Sec-7 retary of State by attested copy by the sheriff or his deputies in any county in the State of Maine. The Attorney General is authorized and designated to 8 9 appear, answer and defend this action. 10

Any judgment that may be recovered in this civil 11 action shall be payable from the State Treasury on 12 13 file process issued by the Superior Court, or, if applicable the Supreme Judicial Court and costs may be 14 taxed for Floris Doiron if she recovers in the ac-15 16 tion. Her recovery shall not exceed \$500,000, including costs. Hearing thereon shall be before a 17 18 Justice of the Superior Court with or without jury; 19 the justice to be the regularly scheduled justice 20 presiding in the Androscoggin County Superior Court 21 when the matter is scheduled for trial.

23This resolve will allow Floris Doiron of Auburn24to bring civil action against the State of Maine.
