Resolve, to Encourage the Safe Disposal of Lead-acid Batteries.

Department of Environmental Protection Study. Resolved: That the Department of Environmental Protection shall conduct a study of the disposal of lead-acid 12-volt batteries. The study shall address the problem of increasing numbers of these batteries being disposed of in municipal landfills and incinerators which are not prepared to handle hazardous materials. In its study, the department shall formulate guidelines to lessen the environmental problems created by the disposal of lead-acid 12-volt batteries; and be it further

Report. Resolved: That the department shall submit its report, together with any necessary implementing legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature by January 31, 1988.

The purpose of this resolve is to cause a study of the environmental problems and issues raised by unsafe disposal of lead-acid 12-volt batteries. The department will report to the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature with recommendations to lessen environmental problems caused by such disposal.
