7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16	This bill requires total appropriations of \$96,306 in fiscal year 1987-88 and \$292,593 in fiscal year 1988-89 to the State Supplement to Federal Supplemental Security Income. Additional increases in the appropriations to this account will be required through fiscal year 1990-91. In addition, 2 years after school units begin to feel the increased pressure of rising minimum wages on their operating costs, additional appropriations to General Purpose Aid for Local Schools will be required to meet the increases in school subsidies.'
18	STATEMENT OF FACT
19 20 21 22 23 24	This amendment adds an appropriation and fiscal note to the bill. It also ensures that the minimum "tipping" wage paid to service employees who receive tips will remain unchanged, as long as the employee receives enough income from his tips to receive the required minimum wage.
