1 L.D. 1170 2 (Filing No. S-115) 3 STATE OF MAINE 4 SENATE 5 113TH LEGISLATURE 6 FIRST REGULAR SESSION 7 SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 869, L.D. 1170, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Minimum Wage." 9 Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of 10 the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, 11 line 5 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.' 12 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end 13 before the statement of fact the following: 'Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §664, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1985, c. 576, is further amended to read: 14 15 16 In determining the wage of a service employee, 17 the amount paid such employee by his employer shall 18 be deemed to be increased on account of tips by an 19 amount determined by the employer, but not by an 20 amount in excess of \$1.54-in-1986,-and-\$1.64-beginning-on-January- $\frac{1}{7}$ $\frac{1.64}{10}$ in 1987, $\frac{1.74}{10}$ in 1988, $\frac{1.84}{10}$ in 1989 and $\frac{1.94}{1.94}$ starting January 1, 1990, ex-cept that in the case of an employee who, either him-21 22 23 self or acting through his representative, shows to 24 25 the satisfaction of the director that the actual 26 amount of tips received by him was less than the 27 amount determined by the employer as the amount by 28 which the wage paid him was deemed to be increased, 29 the amount paid such employee by his employer shall 30 be deemed to have been increased by such lesser 31 amount. SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 869, L.D. 1170 MENT OF 1 2 State Supplement to 3 Federal Supplemental 4 Security Income 5 All Other \$96,306 \$292,593 6 FISCAL NOTE 7 This bill requires total appropriations of \$96,306 in fiscal year 1987-88 and \$292,593 in fiscal 8 year 1988-89 to the State Supplement to Federal Sup-9 10 plemental Security Income. Additional increases in 11 the appropriations to this account will be required 12 through fiscal year 1990-91. In addition, 2 years 13 after school units begin to feel the increased pres-14 sure of rising minimum wages on their operating 15 costs, additional appropriations to General Purpose Aid for Local Schools will be required to meet the 16 increases in school subsidies.' 17 18 STATEMENT OF FACT 19 This amendment adds an appropriation and fiscal note to the bill.
