1 Resolve, to Amend the Reporting Date of the  
2 Special Commission to Study Teacher  
3 Training in the University of Maine  
4 System.

6 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves  
7 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90  
8 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;  
9 and

10 Whereas, the Legislature, in Resolve 1985, chap-  
11- 52, created the Special Commission to Study  
12 Teacher Training in the University of Maine System,  
13 which was to submit a report to the First Regular  
14 Session of the 113th Legislature; and

1       Whereas, much of the information requested in the  
2       resolve has been collected, but some information re-  
3       mains to be collected, including a survey on teacher  
4       attitudes which is crucial to the veracity of the fi-  
5       nal report; and

6       Whereas, many reforms are being currently imple-  
7       mented in the education programs at the various cam-  
8       puses of the University of Maine and consequently  
9       more time is needed to analyze the impact of these  
10      new programs; and

11      Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
12      these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
13      the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
14      legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
15      vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
16      therefore, be it

17      Resolved: That the date for the submission of  
18      the report to the First Regular Session of the 113th  
19      Legislature is changed so that the commission shall  
20      report to the Second Regular Session of the 113th  
21      Legislature.

22      Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited  
23      in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when  
24      approved.

26      This resolve amends the reporting date of the
