1 2	AN ACT to Regulate Electrical Wiring.
3 4	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
5 6	<pre>Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §2557, first ¶ is repealed and the following enacted to read:</pre>
7 8	In any city or town in the State which has pro- vided by resolution or ordinance for electrical in-
9 10	spection in accordance with this subchapter if said resolution or ordinance so provides, no electrical
11	equipment shall be installed within or on any build-
12 13	ing, structure or premises, publicly or privately owned, nor shall any alteration or addition be made
14 15	in any such existing equipment without first securing a permit therefor from the electrical inspector, ex-
16	cept minor repair work, including the replacement of

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12	fuses, sockets, lamps and light parts, repair or in- stallation of radio and low voltage equipment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

13 The purpose of this bill is to require a permit 14 from the electrical inspector of a municipality or 15 the Electricians' Examining Board for all electrical 16 wiring and repair, unless it is minor.

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
