SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 885, L.D. 1186,
Bill, "AN ACT to Require the Members of the Maine
Turnpike Authority to be Confirmed."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of
section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Application. Members of the Maine Turn-
pike Authority who are serving a term of office on
the effective date of this Act shall continue to
serve until their terms expire.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sec-
tions to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the confirmation process
for the Executive Director of the Maine Turnpike Au-
thority which is not necessary since the executive
director serves at the pleasure of the authority and
allows members of the Maine Turnpike Authority to
serve out their terms.
