Resolve, to Study Heating Oil, Gasoline and Propane Gas Pricing Factors in the State.

Study established. Resolved: That the Petroleum Products Market Study Committee shall conduct a study of the factors influencing the distribution and pricing of automotive gasoline, number 2 heating oil and propane gas in this State and related consumer protection laws and regulations. The study shall evaluate historical data on wholesale and retail prices of automotive gasoline, number 2 heating oil and propane gas in order to determine the amount of the retail price markup; and be it further

Committee established; terms; compensation. Resolved: That the Petroleum Products Market Study Committee be established and comprised of the follow-

The committee members shall be appointed within 30 days of the effective date of this legislation. The legislative members shall receive the legislative per diem and the other members shall receive compensation for expenses only; and be it further

Resolved: That the committee shall issue a report, stating their conclusions regarding the changes in the economic makeup of the retail sector which have effected these prices. In the report, the committee shall inform the legislature, the public and involved businesses, of trends in the make up of the wholesale and retail distribution network for these products and suggest any necessary legislation needed to reduce structural constraints in this business sector and to provide further protection for retail distributors and consumers. This report, together with any necessary implementing legislation, shall be submitted to the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature; and be it further
