7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 897, L.D. 8 1198, Bill, "AN ACT to Implement Project ASPIRE for 9 High School Students in the State."

10 Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all 11 of subsection 5 and inserting in its place the fol-12 lowing:

13 '5. Courses may be offered during the regular 14 school day or, if determined appropriate by the board 15 of trustees and the local school board, outside of 16 the traditional school day or week.'

Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 35 to 39 17 18 19 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 20 'In setting up, conducting and evaluating the pilot 21 projects, the board shall give consideration to pro-22 grams offered outside the traditional school day or 23 week, offering courses through audio-visual and computer network hookups, the issue of recognition and 24 25 transferability of credits by the university system 26 and the possibility of participation in the university system program by nonhigh school students. The board of trustees shall conduct a preliminary review 27 28 29 of the operation of the pilot projects and report their findings to the Governor and the Joint Standing 30 31 Committee on Education by April 1, 1988. A final re-32 port shall be issued by March 1, 1989.

33 Further amend the Bill in section 5 by inserting 34 after the 6th line the following:

But 'Educational and General Activities University of Maine System'
