COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 897, L.D.  
1198, Bill, "AN ACT to Implement Project ASPIRE for  
High School Students in the State."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all  
of subsection 5 and inserting in its place the fol-  
lowing:

'5. Courses may be offered during the regular  
school day or, if determined appropriate by the board  
of trustees and the local school board, outside of  
the traditional school day or week.'

Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking  
out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 35 to 39  
in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:  
'In setting up, conducting and evaluating the pilot  
projects, the board shall give consideration to pro-  
grams offered outside the traditional school day or  
week, offering courses through audio-visual and com-  
puter network hookups, the issue of recognition and  
transferability of credits by the university system  
and the possibility of participation in the universi-  
ty system program by nonhigh school students. The  
board of trustees shall conduct a preliminary review  
of the operation of the pilot projects and report  
their findings to the Governor and the Joint Standing  
Committee on Education by April 1, 1988. A final re-  
port shall be issued by March 1, 1989.'
