Administration. Funds appropriated un-7 der this Act shall be administered by the trustee of 8 the Music Performance Trust Funds, 1501 Broadway, New 9 York, New York, under the conditions imposed by this Act. If the trustee declines to administer those 10 funds or fails, before January 1, 1988, to signify 11 12 his acceptance, this Act is repealed and the money appropriated shall revert immediately to the General 13 14 Fund. Secretary of State and furnishes a copy of this acceptance to the Treasurer of State, money from the appropriation shall be paid out on claims by the trustee as other claims against the State are paid.

Sec. 3. Use of funds. The trustee may use no more than 10% of the total money expended for the payment of industrial insurance, unemployment compensation, federal taxes on employment and similar charges. In addition, he may expend money appropriated under this Act to pay his actual expenses of travel in administering the funds. Performances must 12 .... be arranged throughout the State.

20 Sec. 5. Use of funds for local cultural activi-21 The trustee may use money appropriated under ties. 22 this Act for local cultural activities to present performances by instrumental musicians: 23

24 Which are presented in this State in public 1. parks, public facilities, universities, colleges, 25 26 schools, hospitals and other institutions; and

27 2. For which no fee is charged to the public, 28 students, patients or other persons for attendance.

29 The costs for which the trustee may expend money include the compensation of instrumental musicians, 30 31 vocalists and technicians and, where necessary, the 32 cost of their transportation, lodging and meals to and from performances. 33

34 Appropriation. There is appropriated Sec. 6. from the General Fund, for the fiscal year 1987-88, 35 36 the sum of \$150,000 to carry out the purposes of this 37 Act.
